REFWORKS FOR CITATIONS

Link your students to RefWorks, an online citation management tool that will help them to collect, store, and manage bibliographic information in order to more easily prepare appropriately formatted bibliographies and in-text citations or footnotes. Helps to avoid plagiarism!
